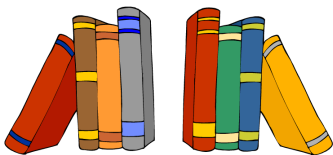

Last week the children brought home a letter explaining a little bit about a charity we will be supporting, **Sal's Shoes**.

On Friday, our school year ends and our children begin their long summer holidays. Before they run for the doors, we want them to change another child's life on the way out . . .

We have asked that, on Friday, any child who is able to donate their school shoes (or another pair) take them off, place them on their desk, and leave school barefoot. We will give the donated shoes to a child in Africa via the wonderful work of the charity Sal's Shoes.

So those shoes, which are unlikely to be used again because feet grow over the summer or are a little scuffed so will be replaced in time for the new school year, won't just sit in the shoe cupboard getting in the way, but will have a second life. We'd love your child to take part.

A whole school leaving barefoot is a powerful message that we want to help those fellow school children who have no choice and leave school barefoot every day. Please help us to help others who are less fortunate than ourselves.

As the charity relies on donations to get the shoes to remote countries and this can be very costly, we have asked if each child could bring **£1** to accompany their shoes to help them find their 'new feet'. To find out more you can visit www.salsshoes.com or <https://www.facebook.com/salsshoes>
