<p><u>Possible Learning Outcomes</u></p> <p>What are your toys made of and how can we classify them? What are the main reasons for choosing materials for different parts of school? What else could you find that is made of: metal; glass; plastic and wood? Can you think of the advantages and disadvantages of some common materials? Can you make a toy using a range of materials and explain why you have chosen the materials? How are different materials used for different musical instruments?</p> <p><u>Reflection:</u> Each group take a different material and give a presentation about their chosen material.</p>	<p><u>Possible Learning Outcomes</u></p> <p>What does Sean O’Loughlin do to keep healthy? What is he especially good at and what are sport do you enjoy? Why would it not be sensible for Sean to eat sweets every day? Which fruits grow naturally in our country? Which fruits provide good opportunities for print work? Where would we most likely find bananas, oranges and grapes growing?</p> <p><u>Reflection:</u> Can you make up a TV advert to eat more healthily?</p>	<p><u>Possible Learning Outcomes</u></p> <p>Who does this egg belong to? What does a dinosaur need to survive? What can you find out about a particular dinosaur? How can you recreate your own dinosaur land? How can you classify dinosaurs? How can we recreate the sounds and movements of the dinosaurs? How do you know that the dinosaurs really roamed the earth?</p> <p><u>Reflection:</u> Can you produce your own dinosaur dance? (Walk the dinosaur)</p>	<p><u>Possible Learning Outcomes</u></p> <p>What does a chef do? Where do chefs get their ingredients from? How can we grow our own ingredients? Why are earthworms really helpful creatures? Who is Archimboldo and what can we learn from him? What would me special meal look like?
