The government remains committed to provide additional funding to schools for the academic year 2016/2017. The purpose of the grant is to fund improvements for the provision of sport and PE so that all pupils aged 5 – 11 year olds develop healthy lifestyles. This year Sacred Heart will receive £9710 to support and improve the quality and breadth of PE provision.

The Governing Body has planned to use the Sports Premium Grant to support the children in their learning in the following ways.
