## INFORMATION FOR SPORTS DAYS

**Sports Days are: Key Stage 1** on Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> June at 10.00am (on the all-weather pitch at St. John Fisher) and **Key Stage 2** on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> June at 1.30pm (on the school field). Parents and carers are welcome to come and spectate. If the weather is not kind to us on the day, we will make a decision to cancel as soon as possible and inform parents by text message and the school website.

Children should come to school in their uniform and get changed into PE kits at school. Please remember to send trainers (KS2 only), a **water bottle** and, depending on the weather, a warm jacket or sun hat and sun cream.

In response to questions raised by parents we have included 'Do and Why' information below.

### SPORTS DAYS—HELPFUL INFORMATION

<u>DO</u>	<u>WHY</u>
Enter through Sacred Heart grounds and please be considerate of local residents when parking.	To ensure the safety of St John Fisher pupils and to maintain good relationships with our neighbours.
Sit and stand in designated spectator areas.	So all parents and carers can see their child.
Do remember that school is a 'smoke free', 'dog free' site.	To keep children safe.
Leave gateways clear at all times.	In case of an emergency we have access.
Bring plenty of drinks for yourself but not the participants.	We will provide all children with a soft drink.
Make sure your child comes to school with a hat and sun cream which has been applied. We will supervise sun cream application before the event if required, however it must come to school labelled with your child's name.	Limited shading and parents will not be able to apply sun cream to participants during the event.
Notify a member of staff if there is an emergency or you need to leave via school before the event finishes.	Once all spectators have arrived school will be made secure – inaccessible.
Take lots of photographs but please don't put other children on social media.	Because before you know it they will be 16 and you will have some happy memories. Some parents do not wish their child's image to be put on the internet without it being approved.
At the end of the event remain in your seat until all pupils have left the field/all weather pitch. Collect your children in the usual way at the end of the day.	This ensures all children are safe and accounted for.
