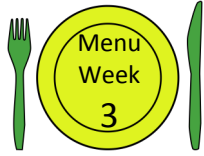

Parish Changes

At church on Sunday Fr Kelly explained the changes to our local parishes and churches.

Sacred Heart, St Cuthbert's and St Edward's parishes will now be known as **one parish**, the **Parish of St Edwards**. However, for the benefit of school admissions the former parish boundaries will remain. So for parents applying for a school place, when asked to which parish do you belong, the answer will be **within the boundary of Sacred Heart Church** or **within the former parish of Sacred Heart**.

Finally... a few weeks ago we sent home a map of the local parish boundaries and asked parents to tell us which parish they live in. This information is required for our forthcoming RE inspection and is not related to the parish changes outlined above. If you have not yet returned this slip please do so as soon as possible.
